The Australian Government, in partnership with the Office of the Deputy President and the Independent Development Trust (IDT), is offering ten (10) Australian Development Scholarships (ADS) in the fields of Science and Technology, ICT, Construction, Project Management, Public Sector Management, Planning and Tourism.

ADS are for study at the Postgraduate Diploma or Masters level in Australia at Australian Universities. ADS are funded and managed by the Australian Government's aid agency, AusAID.

The aim of the 12-24 month scholarships commencing in January 2009, is to give a unique opportunity to South African public-sector professionals to strengthen their skills and expose them to best practice and training in Australia.

Eligibility criteria are available on the website (www.adsafrica.com.au) and include:

- Applicants must be South African public-sector employees (i.e. employed by government or public entities in South Africa within the priority fields)
- At least 2 to 5 years post graduation experience and expertise in the priority fields
- Not currently possessing or studying a Masters degree or PhD
- Possess undergraduate qualifications with a minimum average academic mark of 65%.

Eligible South African Nationals are invited to forward the following documents for consideration:

- A completed Expression of Interest (available on the website: www.adsafrica.com.au)
- A current curriculum vitae
- Certified copies of university degree(s) and transcripts
- Certified copy of your Identity document
- A one-page summary of the reasons for wishing to undertake postgraduate training in Australia and how this training will benefit South Africa.

Failure to complete the application form and submit all documentation requested will lead to automatic disqualification. No undergraduate or PhD nominations will be considered.

Study in Australia is subject to the successful applicant being issued with a visa by the Australian Department of Immigration and Citizenship. This is a long-term partnership and training program with the Australian Government for sustainable development in South Africa.
