Team lists are attached detailing the names of the selected swimmers, the events that they will be swimming and the times that they swam at the Ethekwini Trials.

Please note that there will be no National Tournament as in the past due to the Sports and Recreation SA, DOE and SSA decision to integrate Aquatics Programmes in the country.

The Swimming Federation in the province-KZN Aquatics will take responsibility for Schools' Aquatics in the future. The Schools' Structures will work jointly with the Federation to promote Schools' Aquatics.

School swimmers will now be selected to participate in the SSA Level 1 Regional Championships which will take place in Kimberley from 1-3 April 2011 and Level 2 Regional Championships which takes place in the Free State from 25-28 March 2011 if they qualify according to the SSA Qualifying Times(I AM ATTACHING THE 2010-2011 QUALIFYING TIME STANDARDS). School swimmers will earn points for both their schools and the Club that they belong to.

The KZN Technical Task Team made up of officials from School Structures and the federation will select teams to represent KZN in the Regional Level 1 and Level 2 Championships.

Those swimmers (schools or clubs) who qualify for Level 3 will participate in the SSA Level 3 Nationals which takes place from 18-22 March 2011 at Kings Park Pool. School swimmers who are not swimming for clubs and who qualify for the Level 3 Nationals and wish to swim in this event must make representations to KZN Aquatics immediately (closing date for entries is 21 February 2011).

The teams for Level 1 and Level 2 will be selected from the times on the KZNA database (from 1 May 2010 to date), the Ethekeeni Trials results (22/23 January 2011) and the KZN Schools' Aquatics Championships (19/20 February 2011).

Some swimmers who will not swim in the Provincial Championships can still qualify to swim in the Level 1 and Level 2 Regional Championships.

NOTE:

1. All swimmers who have been selected to represent the Ethekeeni Region in the KZN Schools' Aquatics Championships are to contribute R60,00 for the Ethekeeni Regional Swimming cap.
2. The Ethekeeni Region Team is to meet management at the area adjacent to the usual event stewarding area AT Kings Park Pool **NO LATER THAN 6:45.**
3. Please confirm (by e-mail) **YOUR RECEIPT OF THIS NOTICE** by latest **9 February 2011 (WEDNESDAY)** and your swimmer(s) participation in the Provincial Championships by **NO LATER THAN 11 FEBRUARY 2011 (FRIDAY).**
